THE BALINT GROUPS – A BRIEF INTRODUCTION

The **Balint groups and the Balint method** were developed and named after Michael Balint (1896–1970). The Balint Method aims to raise awareness of Doctors and other Mental Health and Social Care Professionals, about the key role of the unconscious procedures in shaping the relationship between doctor/therapist and patient/client, and how they should be managed.

Balint Groups are a part of medical curricula and are also included in training schemes in relevant social sciences. Balint groups consist of 8–12 members with a medical or psychosocial professional background who observe and analyse the 'doctor-patient relationship' under the supervision of an accredited Balint Group Leader. Current or past sessions with the patient are presented as a 'case' to get a more in-depth understanding. The presentation of the case is based on the subjective memory without the use of notes or medical records. In this way, both the speaker/presenter and the participants of the group acquire an emotional impression of the presented relationship.

The members of the group then express their impressions, feelings, and fantasies in relation to the presented case. This forms an extensive and multidimensional picture of the doctor/therapist-patient relationship ('transference and countertransference'). The speaker receives suggestions for new prospects, light is shed at the 'blind spots' through another perspective, relevant emotions are intensified that all lead to a better recognition of the potential patterns and the impact on the patient. The outcome of the analysis of the therapist/patient relationship which has been clarified through different perspectives, benefits the therapist, the patient as well as the participants of the Balint Group.

Balint groups are used to ensure the high quality of the medical and therapeutic work and to prevent professional burnout as the speaker quite often gets the sense of emotional relief.

In **Psychodrama-Balint**, the Group Leader asks the case presenter to tell the story of the consultation and in collaboration of members of the group to play different moments of the relationship with the patient.

Those moments of psychodramatic play are the added aspect to the method. Before and after every scene of play, the Group work is same as in any other Balint group.
